So, did you notice a common thread running through my column this month? It's really what RCB is all about:



Spring B&B Ride

June 19-20, 2004

The Spring Bed & Breakfast Ride is scheduled for the last two days of Spring, Saturday June 19th and Sunday June 20th. Organized by Greg and Cyndee Peart and Tom and Helen Austin, the destination will be the historic Fall River Hotel in Fall River Mills, CA. Fall River Mills is a quiet little town located about 70 miles northeast of Redding on Highway 299, at an elevation of about 3,500 feet. The population of the town has been about 600 for over 100 years. Principal economic activity in the region is cattle ranching, rice and alfalfa farming, and tourism. The bar and dining room at the Fall River Hotel is not only a popular gathering place for locals, it attracts tourists from outside of the area who are interested in enjoying good food in a quiet and relaxing atmosphere.

The ride to Fall River Mills will begin at Granzella's Deli, located just off of Interstate 5 in Williams, CA, 55 miles north of Sacramento. A no-host breakfast at Granzellas will be at 8:00 a.m. The ride will begin at 9:00 a.m. sharp. The final route will depend on weather and road conditions but will likely involve scenic two-lane roads like SR70 through the Feather River Canyon.

Total riding distance from Granzella's will be approximately 240 miles. There will be a quick, 10-minute stop about an hour into the ride. There will be a 45-minute break at about the midpoint of the ride, probably at a coffee house south of Lake Al-

manor. Fuel will be available at this stop for those who need it. There will be one more quick stop before reaching Fall River Mills at about 2:30-3:00 p.m.

After check-in, there will be a hosted wine and cheese tasting in the hotel dining room at 4:00 p.m. There will be more than a dozen good wines to sample, along with a variety of cheeses and breads. Dinner will be served at 7:00 p.m. There will be several entre choices ranging from prime rib to vegetarian. The hotel bar will remain open after dinner.


Sunday morning there will be a hosted, family style breakfast served for our group at 8:00 a.m. After breakfast, the ride back to the Sacramento area will begin at 9:30 a.m. and will follow a slightly different route. We will do a no-host, afternoon lunch stop somewhere along the way.

Cost for a room, the wine tasting, dinner, and breakfast at the hotel, including tips, will be approximately \$200 for couples and \$130 for singles. Final prices will be available soon. BARNS


