

the GS-911's so he is not the sole source of diagnostic wisdom in the Club. The Sea Gull Inn event (aka "Couples' Weekend") is March 13-15 and there are still a few rooms available. Our annual Morro Bay ride is in April. May starts with the Louis Lewis Memorial Poker Run and concludes with the Spring Classic at the Trinity KOA. Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Last Month's Minutes: The Minutes from the January meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report – Current Assets: \$8,501.76 - 2015 YTD Net Income- loss (\$230.92). Full Treasurers Report dated Jan 31, 2015 is attached.

Membership Report – 200 members

Old Business

2015 Budget – Dave presented the 2015 Planned Budget for review along with a summary of the income/expense incurred during 2014. With a seen disparity between expected income and planned costs, a detailed review of the Profit & Loss statement along with discussion on how to put forth a balanced budget ensued. Actions taken:

The 2015 Event Budget was approved. Co-pays to be charged on overnight events to cover incurred expenses.

The overall 2015 Preliminary Budget was approved with further alignment of costs to be made per the above action taken. Further discussion planned to determine if other income resources to be initiated to ensure a balanced 2015 budget.

GS911 Diagnostic Tool – Ken has ordered to GS911 Tool (cost approximately \$700). Availability of this tool for use by all club members to be announced at March 7 meeting.

Three Flags Classic Tour 2015 – Jeanie provided the update that 245 participants have signed up (300 available spots) and an additional event day has been added. She will post an updated on the website.

New Business

Morro Bay – The monthly ride to Morro Bay is scheduled for April 17-19. Rand to post an update and sign-up list on the Forum so a room count can be provided to the Morro Crest Hotel.

Membership Inquiry – Ray presented an inquiry received proposing that future membership fees be waived for "founding RCB members." The Board considered the request and agreed that some kind of recognition of founding members is fitting – i.e. an introduction at the Christmas party or an article in the newsletter was discussed. Before moving forward, a list of surviving members will need to be established.

GPS Tech Day – Jeanie informed the group that the Gold Country Riders are having a GPS Tech Day. With discussion that a similar event maybe of interest to RCB'ers, Jeanie offered to reach out to the instructor on willingness to add another tech session.

Clearwater Lights – Gordy has reached out to Clearwater Lights to see if they'd like to update the club on their products – no response yet received.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:52 pm.


